MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2004-005

SUBJECT: AMENDING MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2003-028 SO AS TO INCLUDE IN THE EXCEPTION OF MORATORIUM FOR APPLICATION OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE FOR THE STRONG REPUBLIC NAUTICAL HIGHWAY (RO-RO) ROUTES FOR PUBLIC UTILITY BUSES

Pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2003-028, dated November 17, 2003, all acceptance of new applications for the issuance of CPCs for all types of land transportation service were temporarily suspended except Truck-for-Service. In addition to the exception, moratorium for Shuttle Services and Tourist Airconditioned PUJ Service were earlier lifted as per Memorandum Circular No. 2004-003 dated February 24, 2004.

In consonance to the President's Priority Project under the Strong Republic Nautical Highway (RO-RO) Routes, the Board hereby declares the opening and resumption for the Acceptance of New Application of Certificate of Public Convenience for Strong Republic Nautical Highway (RO-RO) Routes for Public Utility Buses (PUB's) only.

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuance inconsistent herewith.

This Memorandum shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in the Official Gazette, or in a newspaper of general circulation, or the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the U.P. Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11 dated 09 October 1992.

This Memorandum Circular shall be applicable nationwide and effective immediately.
