



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2005-009

**Subject: ACCEPTANCE OF PETITIONS/APPLICATIONS FOR
EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF EXPIRED CERTIFICATES OF
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE FROM 01 JANUARY 2004 UP TO 31 MARCH 2005**

After a thorough evaluation of the recommendations of the Regional Directors of this Board and the countless appeals of operators, the Board hereby allows the acceptance of Petitions/Applications for Extension of Validity of Expired Certificates of Public Convenience (CPC), subject to the following conditions:

1. Only PUJ, PUB, and Taxi Services are covered by this Circular;
2. Only CPC which expired from 01 January 2004 up to 31 March 2005 are allowed for acceptance;
3. The regular penalty for late filing in the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 500.00) per unit and per month shall still be charged; and,
4. In addition to the regular penalty abovementioned, the following penalties shall also be imposed regardless of the number of months of expiration:
 - a.) **PUJ Service – Five Thousand Pesos (PhP 5,000.00) per unit;**
 - b.) **Taxi Service – Seven Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 7,500.00) per unit; and,**
 - c.) **PUB Service – Fifteen Thousand Pesos (PhP 15,000.00) per unit.**

Operators who are covered by this Circular and who may want to avail of this privilege are given until 30 June 2005 to file their Petitions/Applications.

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith, and takes effect **immediately**.
