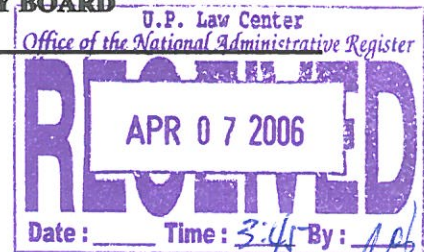

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NUMBER** 2006-023

**SUBJECT: EXEMPTIONS FOR OUT OF LINE OPERATIONS**

Due to the complaints of Transport Associations/Organizations regarding the apprehension of traffic enforcers for "Out of Line Operations", this Board resolved to enumerate instances and incidents where out of line operations is allowed.

For proper guidance of traffic enforcers, the following are not considered Out of Line Operations:

1. When the driver is avoiding heavy traffic due to flood, repair of public highways and streets and the like;
2. When the driver is from or going back to its authorized garage to and from the point of its authorized route, provided it has no passengers;
3. When the driver is going to eat for breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks, provided it should not be more than a 500 meter radius from the authorized route;
4. When there is a temporary re-routing scheme by the Local Government Unit, provided, that they can present a copy of the temporary re-routing ordinance or plan;
5. When the unit is being used for emergency, personal, and family use, as provided under Memorandum Circular No. 91-014

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation or in Official Gazette.
