



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2006 - 038

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENT ON MC 2006-027, RE: CONVERSION TO
LPG FED ENGINE**

This Board hereby amends and modifies MC 2006-027 dated May 13, 2006, so that it should now read as follows:

“To encourage grantees of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) to Operate Taxi Air-Conditioned Service to convert their engines to Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) fed, taxi operators who shall convert their engines shall have an additional three (3) years in the validity date of their CPC’s which makes the validity period from five (5) to eight (8) years, provided that all its units shall comply with the thirteen (13) years maximum age requirement for Taxi Services.

Be it noted that the additional three (3) years is not automatic and shall be added to the validity of the CPC only after inspection. Petition for Extension of Validity with LPG conversion should be filed and heard by the Board alleging therein that it complied with this Memorandum Circular.”

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect immediately
