



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

**SUBJECT: DEFINING THE EXTENT OF COLORUM OPERATIONS IN
RELATION TO MC 2006-062**

In relation to Memorandum Circular 2006-062, Re: IMPLEMENTATION OF POINT TO POINT EXPRESS SERVICE (P2P) "COLORUM" LEGALIZATION PROGRAM IN CRITICALLY IDENTIFIED ROUTES IN THE SUPER REGIONS OF CENTRAL PHILIPPINES (REGIONS 5,6,7 & 8) AND MINDANAO (REGIONS 9,10,11,12 & CARAGA), the following are deemed engaging in "COLORUM OPERATIONS"

1. When the unit/s is/are operating as for hire vehicle without the required Certificates of Public Convenience from this Board;
2. When the unit/s, although authorized to operate as for hire vehicle/s, is/are operating outside its authorized route or operating not in accordance with the authorized denomination granted by the Board ;
3. When the unit/s, although authorized to operate as for hire vehicles is/are operating under expired Certificate/s of Public Convenience, as of year 2000 without the necessary Decision or Application/Petition for Extension of Validity;
4. When the unit/s is/are operating under spurious, fraudulent and fake Certificate/s of Public Convenience

Anent to the aforesaid Memorandum Circular, only applicants with apprehension/s prior to the effectivity of the said Memorandum may avail of the Colorum Legalization Program. Those who will be authorized to be holders of

Certificates of Public Convenience under the said program shall not be allowed to sell and transfer the CPC's nor to drop & substitute units within 5 years.

The deadline for the filing of the said Application pursuant this program shall be on December 31, 2006.

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation or in Official Gazette.
