



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

**SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION REGARDING CONVERSION TO LPG
FED ENGINE**

In order to properly harmonize Memorandum Circular 2006-027 dated May 12, 2006. Re: CONVERSION TO LPG FED ENGINE, and Memorandum Circular 2006-038 dated June 5, 2006, Re: AMENDMENT ON MC 2006-027 with respect to the maximum age requirement for taxi services.

This Board hereby clarifies and modifies MC 2006-038, so that it should now read as follows:

“To encourage grantees of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) to Operate Taxi Air-Conditioned Service to convert their engines to Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) fed, taxi operators who shall convert their engines shall be granted an additional two (2) years to the existing thirteen (13) years maximum age requirements for taxi services which makes the maximum age requirement for taxi services to fifteen (15) years.

Be it noted that the additional two (2) years is not automatic and shall be added to the validity of the CPC only after actual inspection to be conducted by duly authorized personnel of this Board. Petition for Extension of Validity with LPG conversion should be filed and heard by the Board alleging therein that it complied with this Memorandum Circular.”

All taxi units converted to LPG are required to submit to the Board a certification its conversion to LPG including the conversion shops accreditation of documents from their partner oil company.

This Memorandum Circular supersedes any and all issuances inconsistent herewith, and shall take effect immediately
