MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2012- 028

**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF LATE FILING OF APPLICATIONS FOR
 EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF CPC FOR SELECT TRANSPORT SERVICES**

Previously, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2010-027 and related circulars which prohibits the late filing of Applications for Extension of Validity of CPC.

Considering that there are several transport services which are exempted from the moratorium policy, the Board hereby allows the late filing of applications for extension of validity of CPC under the following guidelines:

1. This Circular shall apply to : **Trucks for Hire, School Transport, Shuttle Service, and Tourist Transport**
2. This shall cover only those solely for Extension of Validity of CPC. Any other application/petition apart from extension of validity (such as sale and transfer, dropping and substitution, etc.) shall not be allowed.
3. Only those which expired from January 1, 2012 onwards shall be allowed to file within one year from date of expiry of CPC.
4. Applicable penalty charges shall be collected in the amount of **FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) PLUS FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) PER MONTH OF DELAY.**
5. Inspection of units shall be conducted with the Inspection Report to be submitted together with the Application for Extension of Validity of CPC. Applicants shall coordinate with the Technical Evaluation Division (TED) on the schedule of inspection of unit/s.
6. The existing policy on year model of units shall be strictly observed.

All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby modified, amended, or superseded accordingly.

This Memorandum shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.

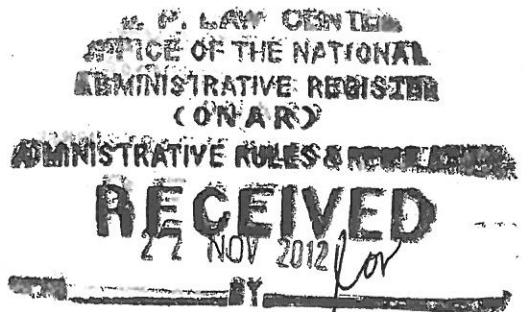
