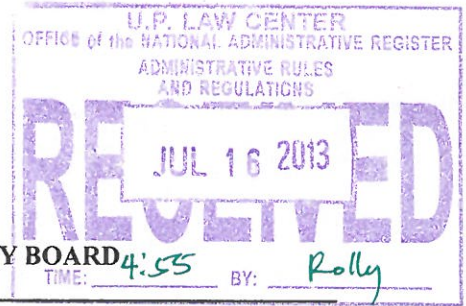

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2010-003

**SUBJECT : PENALTY FOR SUBMITTING FAKE OR SPURIOUS DOCUMENTS
 AND OTHER MISPRESENTATIONS TO THE BOARD
 (AMENDING THE PENALTIES IMPOSED UNDER
 MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2006-031 DATED MAY 12, 2006)**

It has come to the attention of the Board that certain parties have been submitting spurious or fake documents as part of their applications/petitions and other pleadings if only to comply with the documentary requirements of the Board. Further, cases of misrepresentations have been encountered by the Board during the hearing and/or evaluation of cases.

Thus, the Board, in the exercise of its power embodied in Section 5 of Executive Order No. 202, as well as pertinent provisions of the Public Service Act, hereby imposes the penalty of **REVOCATION/CANCELLATION of the Certificate/s of Public Convenience, after due notice and hearing, for all cases with fake or spurious documents submitted and/or misrepresentations employed by applicants/operators.**

All officials and employees are directed to report immediately to the Board and/or Regional Director concerned of the discovery of fake or spurious documents and/or misrepresentations.

All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby modified, amended, or superseded accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.
