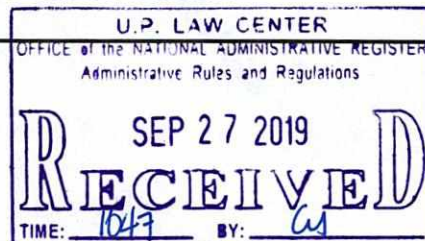

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2019- 051

SUBJECT: Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2018-026 (Reduction in the Minimum Number of Units per Application)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, dated June 19, 1987, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power "to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles, xxx";

WHEREAS, the Board, on 19 December 2018 issued Memorandum Circular No. 2018-026, opening additional CPCs equivalent to Five Thousand (5,000) units of Airconditioned Taxi Service for Metro Manila including the so-called MUCEP Area, where the prescribe minimum number of units per Application is one hundred (100) units and the maximum is set at one thousand (1,000) units;

WHEREAS, months have passed but only few have applied, leaving a considerable number of units remain unfilled and needed to be supplied in order to satisfy the 5,000 units so as to address the growing tourism industry, population and economic development in the Greater Manila Area;

WHEREAS, the clamor of the stakeholders has come to the attention of the Board, that majority of them who are interested to apply could hardly afford and/or comply the requirements necessary to operate the minimum 100 units;

WHEREAS, the Board, after consultation with several operators, sees the need to reduce the minimum number of units per Application so as to encourage more interested applicants to submit their intent to apply;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Board hereby reduced the minimum number of units per Application to TWENTY FIVE (25) units and the maximum remains at one thousand (1,000) units.

All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby modified, amended, or superseded accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the UP Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11, dated 09 October 1992.

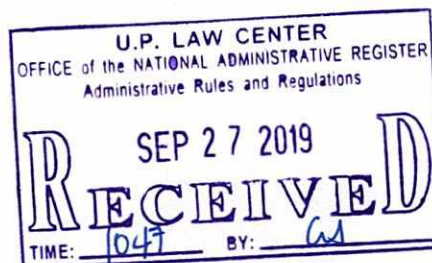
